Dear Parents and Carers,

January Opening Information – Staggered Return & Mass Testing

Firstly, I apologise for this late communication. Unfortunately, the Department for Education (DfE) only released guidance yesterday regarding a staggered return to school following the Christmas holiday. The contents of this letter is subject to change, as at the time of writing, the plans from the DfE have not been shared with schools and colleges.

Below are the arrangements we have planned for following the Christmas break.

Years 7, 8 & 9 – Students in Years 7, 8 & 9 should **remain at home until Monday 11th January.**

Remote learning will be provided from **Monday 4th January** and can be accessed through Microsoft Teams as usual. It is our intention that the normal school timetable will be followed; therefore, students should be ready and prepared to learn at the start of every lesson. Some lessons may be **streamed live, pre-recorded or the lesson resources shared** and therefore it is important students **follow their usual timetable** at the usual time.

Please note that there may be a difference in the remote learning styles depending on each individual teacher, therefore, not all lessons will be live. During this time students should spend the time doing the work that has been shared on Teams. All the information regarding remote learning is available on our website.

May I ask that parents and carers of Year 10 and 11 students remind them of the changes to the start of the school day the first day back.


Mass Testing
