The appointment booking system allows you to choose your own video appointment times with teachers and you will receive an email confirming your appointments. We are confident this be a useful way to share your Son/Daughter's progress.

Appointments can be made from Friday 14th January and will close on Tuesday 18th January. Should you wish to make any changes after this date please contact the school office. If you do not have access to the internet, please contact the school office who will be happy to add appointments on your behalf so we can make alternate arrangements.
