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### DEAR PARENTS AND CARERS

It has been a busy two weeks since our last edition and you will find all the updates within this newsletter.

We have also held our 'Meet the Tutor' session for Year 7, who have settled in brilliantly. Thank you to all the tutors and **Mrs Dixon** and **Miss Heath** for supporting Year 7 to make a very positive start. Inside you will also find our extra-curricular timetable and I would encourage as many students as possible to attend extra-curricular activities after school as this is a great way to learn new skills and meet new people.

I would also like to ask for your support in ensuring your children attend school regularly and on time. As we enter a time of the year when bugs are more common, I would like to have your support with the following. If your child

is well enough to get out of bed, please send them in and if needed ask them to speak with either their Form Tutor, Progress Leader or Assistant Progress Leader. We can then check in on them throughout the day if required. If it gets to a point where they need to go home, we can then contact you. Ultimately, if students are not on site this has an impact on their attainment and we do not want students to get behind with their work. If your child has any concerns about any aspect of school life, please ask them to speak with their Form Tutor in the first instance as that may resolve issues quickly.

Can I remind you that students should not be carrying their own medication including paracetamol. If your child needs to take any form of medication it should be sent into school, clearly labelled with child's name; this should then be given to their Progress Leader who will administer as per the instructions.

We have also noticed a number of students that are entitled to free school meals are not taking their lunch during the day. Can you please encourage them to do so, as this will help their concentration for learning.

Finally, can I kindly ask for your co-operation in ensuring the bus drop off bays are kept clear and you park elsewhere when dropping off or picking up.

Good attendance and punctuality are essential if you are to succeed at the Academy, in fact research shows that there is a direct link between good attendance and academic progress and achievement.


Children who are late should come to the main school reception where they need to sign-in.

# Tips for Top school attendance:



Make sure your uniform is ready and your school bag packed the night before.



Ensure medical/dental appointments are made out of school hours- if you do have an unavoidable appointment during the school day aim to come into school either before or after the appointment.



Set the alarm clock early enough to allow plenty of time to get ready.



Remember school is open from 8am with Breakfast club running.





If you are unhappy about any aspect of school life, tell someone as soon as possible so we can try to resolve the issue.

If you are under the weather, but well enough for school, come in. If you are too unwell for school, we will contact your parents/guardian and arrange for you to go home.
