Child Development



KEY STAGE 4

At the end of Year 10, students will know about and be able to do the following:

- a basic introduction in to working with children in a variety of settings
- Understanding of the differences between the voluntary, private and statutory sectors and the range of provision within your area
- an understanding of how to prepare for placement
- an understanding of roles and responsibilities when working in a setting
- an introduction to the influences that affect holistic development
- an awareness of learning styles
- an awareness of various study skills including how to reference/write a bibliography
- an awareness of individual needs and ways of working that treat children fairly and in line with current diversity and inclusive practice.
- Know how to safeguard children to keep them safe and healthy

At the end of Year 11, students will know about and be able to do the following:

- an awareness of the care needs of individual children
- an introduction in to everyday care routines and the types of activities that can support the development of independence
- an introduction to observing children and how it supports development
- a basic understanding of the stages and sequence of child development
- an understanding how biological and environmental factors can affect holistic development
- an understanding of various transitions that children age 0 – 5 may face and how it can affect a child's holistic development.
- Understanding how an Early Years Worker can support a child's development
