# The Halewood Curriculum

At Halewood Academy we provide all students with a broad, balanced curriculum whilst preparing them for the challenges ahead. We take great care in personalising the curriculum to meet individual student needs. Students are encouraged to become independent learners and to participate in the wide range of extra-curricular activities that are offered.

We place a strong emphasis on literacy and numeracy as well as developing learning and thinking skills within all curriculum areas. Halewood Academy also provides many excellent leadership initiatives which many of our students take part in.



#### Years 7-9

The move from Primary to Secondary can be difficult and is a vital time in a child's life. We work hard, in partnership with primary schools, to make that transition as smooth and successful as possible.

The Key Stage 3 curriculum builds effectively on prior learning at Primary School and is flexible enough to be adapted to meet with individual needs of students. Students are offered the opportunity to experience a broad range of subjects before choosing their GCSE options in Year 9. Throughout Key Stage 3 parents receive regular feedback about the progress of their child.

#### Years 10-11

Students continue to access the core curriculum, as well as subjects they are particularly interested in or have shown a passion for. Students follow a learning pathway which best meets their needs. There are a wide range of qualifications on offer to all our students, including vocational studies that are delivered off site by specialist providers.

We take great pride in our Pastoral care. Each year group is led by a non-teaching Progress Team which is extremely important, as it allows each team the time they need to look after their year group.

A calm, orderly environment is essential if students are to learn effectively. The staff recognise the need to provide students with a set of simple rules and code of conduct which enables staff and students to make the most effective use of their time. Furthermore, staff improve students' behaviour for learning by ensuring that lessons are stimulating and by ensuring all students have enough opportunities to learn independently and in groups.

Our priority is to ensure all students make good progress each year. Key staff monitor progress and attainment, identifying students who are not meeting targets, implementing and monitoring relevant intervention strategies and working with subject leaders and teachers in order to improve outcomes for students.

Students who need additional support can access the Progress Centre; specialist staff are on hand to support students social and emotional needs in addition to providing academic support.

We believe that all students deserve to explore a broad and varied curriculum, especially within enrichment. This is where friendships are formed, confidence is built and resilience shown. Students have a variety of options through each subject area. Such opportunities are; art, photography, dance, drama, music, STEM, sporting activities and many more. We have many students who either participate in sporting competitions and/or perform in a variety of theatre productions. Some projects we are involved in range from Shakespeare's Schools Festival, Work Bard, Play Bard and the Brilliant Club. It is important for our students to experience life outside of school. Regular visits have taken place to the Everyman and Playhouse Theatres, Science and dance trips to London, Colomendy residential, Field Work, and international trips to the Alps and Barcelona.
